Junior Forest Wardens Douglas-fir (Pseudotsuga menziesii) planted in Salmon Stream Valley in 1931

Frances Elizabeth Willard white camellia (Camellia) planted in Salmon Stream Valley in 1939

western redcedar (Thuja plicata ) planted in Shakespeare Garden in 1936

western hemlock (Tsuga heterophylla ) planted in Shakespeare Garden in 1936

red oak (Quercus rubra) planted in Shakespeare Garden in 1936

black locust (Robinia pseudoacacia) planted in Shakespeare Garden in 1936

black walnut (Juglans nigra) planted in Shakespeare Garden in 1936

Atlas cedar (Cedrus atlantica) planted in Shakespeare Garden in 1936

Powys Thomas red oak (Quercus rubra) planted in Shakespeare Garden in 1977 or after

silver birch (Betula pendula) known as the Peace Train tree planted north of Ceperley Meadow path in 1988

western redcedar (Thuja plicata) known as the 125th anniversary tree planted at Chaythoos in 2013
